### Treatment Details

**Textblock**  
Front paste-down sheet is tearing and the back paste-down sheet is not fully attached to the cover.

**Sewing**  
Both endbands are detached from textblock but intact with cover; sewing of the textblock is in good condition.

**Treatment Details (continued)**

**Treatment Type:** Other

**Housing Type:** Mylar-spine wrapper

**Proposed Treatment:** 1. Reattach paste-down sheets with wheat starch paste.  
2. Reattach endbands with Japanese paper.

Estimated time: 4 hours

**Treatment Details:** 1. Rolled over front beads of top endband to align, and tacked down with Zen Shofu wheat starch paste (left them loose from textblock as is).  
2. Pasted down the front paste-down sheet with dry Zen Shofu wheat starch paste, and let it dry inbetween hollytex and blotters for a week.  
3. Pasted down the back paste-down sheet with dry paste, and let it dry for another week.  
4. Made mylar spine wrapper with blue corrugated board inner flaps to hold the slightly warped back cover.
